Dear Property Owner/Resident,

An application has been filed to implement a permit parking program in the Wasatch Neighborhood in which you live. The proposal was sponsored by Council Vice-Chair Kim Santiago, and a petition was circulated throughout the neighborhood and received over 130 signatures in its favor. It may be implemented as early as mid-August 2015, including \$15.00 parking permits annually for eligible vehicles for households generally located between N Birch Lane and Locust Lane and between Apple Avenue and Wymount Terrace.

Parking permits can be purchased through Provo City at provo.org/provo311 for each vehicle; two visitor permits per household will be issued free of charge. Regarding on-street parking, current two-hour restrictions will be replaced by 1-hour restrictions from 6 A.M. to 6 P.M. Monday thru Friday. This permit program is anticipated to address:

- Street congestion due to neighborhood proximity to BYU campus
- Ineffective and unenforced on-street regulations for two-hour parking
- Inabilities of residents to accept visitors, send/receive mail, remove snow/debris, etc.
- Safety concerns for pedestrians, especially young children commuting to nearby schools

You are invited to provide public comment at a hearing held on Tuesday, August 4, 2015, beginning at 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers at the City Center Building, 351 W Center St. prior to a Council vote on the program ordinance. See the attached pages for more information.
