

Sundance Ski Program FAQs

1. *What does my program purchase include?*

You will be transported to and from Sundance in a Provo City School bus. We will leave from the Provo Recreation Center at 9:00am and will return at 4:00pm. Once we arrive on the mountain you will have ski/snowboarding lessons from 10:00-12:30pm. After that point, participants are free to eat lunch (sack lunch or lunch money not included) and/or continue to ski until we leave at 4:00pm. They will be supervised by Provo City staff.

2. *Do I have to be a Provo Recreation Center member to register?*

No. There is a price discount if you are a member of the Provo Recreation Center. There is also a price discount if you already have a Sundance season pass. Prices are reflected on-line and calculated as you checkout.

3. *Is this just a youth program?*

No. This program is open to people of all ages. You must be at least eight years of age to participate in the ski lessons and nine years of age to participate in snowboarding. Groups will be broken up according to age and ability level once you arrive at Sundance. However, most people who register are under 18 years of age.

4. *Who will chaperone my child after the lessons?*

When lessons are over, all participants must check in with the Provo Coordinator at the base of the mountain. Students can continue to ski with a buddy or in groups and will be chaperoned by volunteers until we leave at 3:00pm. If parents/guardians would like to ski or take their child home from the resort, they must notify the coordinator and sign them out.

5. *What if I don't have my own equipment?*

You can rent skiing or snowboarding gear for \$20 each session. Helmets are suggested, but not required and are available for rent at \$5. These are separate transactions you can choose on-line.

6. *What if the weather keeps us from making it up to Sundance?*

The bus will attempt to make it regardless. If the weather makes it impassable, then we will go on the first Saturday of February.

7. *What if I miss a session?*

There are no make-up sessions or refunds. There are also no prorated options. If you are not going to make a session, you will incur the cost.
