



Snow Removal

Plowing priority is given first to arterial and collector roads, which are plowed curb to curb, and then secondary and residential streets, where traffic lanes only are initially opened. Routes cover all areas of the city, so no area is neglected or given special treatment.

Salting priorities are also given to arterial and collector roads, but we also salt regulated intersections, hillsides and curves.

Depending on how big the storm is, the salt/sanding routes take an average of 5 hours, and plowing routes take anywhere from 12 – 14 hours to complete.

Following major storms when conditions have moderated, Streets personnel will then include cul-de-sacs/dead ends and removing snow from business areas, depending on build-up.
