

Automotive Industry

- › Use a funnel when pouring liquids such as motor oil or brake fluid.
- › Clean up spills immediately using shop rags or dry absorbent materials.
- › Recycle oil at your local auto parts store. Antifreeze can be recycled at SUVSWD Transfer Station located at 2450 W 400 S in Springville.
- › Do not throw hazardous materials into the trash or down storm drains.
- › Use a commercial car wash facility. Many commercial facilities recycle the water that is used or treat it before discharging it to the sanitary sewer system.
- › If using a commercial facility is not possible, wash the car on gravel, grass, or other areas able to absorb the wash water.
- › Conserve water by using a bucket instead of runny a hose to wash and rinse cars.
