VOTE BY MAIL

FROM THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

It's a sign of modern times and a new way to cast a ballot. In the all Vote-by-Mail election this fall people can mark their ballots on the day they want, from the convenience of their homes, and with enough time to think through their decisions. It's an exciting change, something several cities in Utah are trying out by contracting with Utah County.

All registered voters will be mailed ballots 21 days before the election (Primary Election - August 15th & General Election - November 7th). Voters can make their choices and simply mail them back in. No standing in line. No waiting. No pressure.

Only registered voters will receive ballots in the mail. If you aren't sure that your registration is current, you can easily check on vote.utah.gov. People who have moved should take steps to ensure their address is updated.

If you need to register you can get a form from the Utah County Clerk's Office at 100 East Center St or register online at vote.utah.gov. For more information or for answers to specific questions, call the City Recorder's Office at (801) 852-6524.

A voter service center will be made available on Election Day at the Provo Recreation Center from 7 AM - 8 PM. If you do not receive a ballot in the mail or if you lose/misplace your ballot you can stop by the service center and vote provisionally. Registered voters must bring a current ID (driver license with current address or two items that have current address). A drop box will also be available at the service center for those wanting to submit their completed mail-in ballot (in their signed and sealed envelope).

Please note that because you will receive your mail-in ballot 21 days before the election, there will be no Early Voting.

I'm looking forward to a robust election season and hope we'll all take the time to study the candidates and their messages and cast an informed vote. Please visit voteprovo.com for candidate information, council district maps, vote-by-mail details, and election announcements.

FREE TREES TO HELP REDUCE ENERGY COSTS

REDUCE ENERGY CONSUMPTION AND SAVE

Do you have central air conditioning? If your answer is yes and you are a Provo resident then Provo City Power would like to help you lower your electric bill and energy consumption by offering you a free shade tree. Besides looking good, trees strategically placed around your yard can have a significant impact on your cooling costs. As a locally owned and locally controlled utility, Provo City Power is interested in lowering costs to Provo consumers. Lower power bills save you money and help the utility reduce the need to purchase expensive power especially at peak times.

Trees act as a natural air conditioner, reducing heat and reflection from the sun's hot rays. This natural cooling happens as water evaporates from the leaf's surface into the surrounding air. When the right tree is planted at the proper site, trees can be as beneficial as other energy saving home improvements including insulation, weather stripping, and shade screens. Cooling costs can be reduced 30-50% by proper placement of trees around buildings, air conditioners, and paved areas. Also, lawns shaded by trees use 30-50% less water.

Approximately 20 different tree species will be available to select from. The selection of trees offered by Provo City Power are proven to be the most appropriate for maximum cooling of your home if planted strategically. All trees shed leaves, twigs, flowers or a fruiting structure at some time. There is no tree that is completely maintenance free. You may view various tree species on the Provo City Forestry Division's Tree Selection Guide at provopower.org/forestry.

Remember, when planting your shade trees do not plant them any closer than 25-35 feet perpendicular to any power lines. Determine the shade tree's width at maturity and plant the tree more than half that distance from the power lines.

Residents that have received a tree in the last two years will not be eligible for a tree this year -- Eligibility will be verified.

HOW TO GET YOUR FREE TREE

1. Have central air conditioning in your home.
2. To sign up for your free tree log on to Switchitprovo.com and submit the online form located under Trees for Conservation. Once determined that you are eligible, a voucher for your free tree and instructions will be emailed to you. There is a limited supply and trees will be given out on a first-come first-served basis to customers that qualify. All forms must be submitted no later than Tuesday, September 5th - no vouchers will be processed after that date.
3. Pick up your free tree on September 14th, 2017 at the Provo Power Campus located at 251 West 800 North. Provo City Power Representatives will be available that day to help you and answer any questions you may have. Tree species selection is on a first-come first-served basis.
