Roger Knell was present as chair.

Bruce Camerson presented illustrations of the building and possible changes that he believs would give a better tie-in to the townhomes which are part of the same project.

Dave Rosen, the Riverbottoms Neighborhood Chair reported that this item was discussed at their most recent neighborhood meeting where the majority opinion was that although the building may otherwise be attractive, it does not fit with the Olde Ivy project at this site.

Area residents, Wayne Tanner and Greg Pearson, along with the builder of the townhomes, John Dester, were also in attendance and spoke at the meeting. They voiced their opposition to the current design, but also stated they believe their ideas are not that far apart from the developer's in possible changes to the building elevations, in making it more compatible with the adjoining townhomes and the Jiffy Lube building.

The committee members agreed that they didn't believe the developer and the neighbors were that far apart in what would be considered compatible with the associated development and the corridor design guidelines. They asked the developer to meet with the neighbors to see if there is something that would work for both, that could then be brought back to the committee.
