1. That the metal steeple is removed from the SW corner of the building.

Quinn Peterson was present as chair.

The following is a brief summary of the above decision, including conditions of approval:

- The applicant gave an overview of the building architecture, materials, and design features as they relate to the context of the area and goals for the building.
- The Committee discussed the look of the metal spire at the corner of the building, there were concerns that it would give the wrong look for the building.
- The Committee clarified materials, colors, and design features; specifically talking about the color of the brick and the horizontal line elements. There was concern expressed the horizontal lines on the building. The applicant mentioned that they are to give the building more of a residential look.
- The idea of exterior lighting was discussed, the applicant stated the plan for aluminum fixtures that would be shielded from adjacent properties.
- The motion was made to include the above condition and also two recommendations:
 - 1. That the applicant would consider removing the horizontal banding.
 - 2. That the applicant would consider adding outdoor lighting onto the building.



If changes are made to the plans (Building or Landscaping) which have been approved by the Design Review Commission, a revised plan will need to be reviewed and approved by the Commission. Unauthorized changes to the approved plan are subject to a \$500.00 fee as outlined in Provo City Code Section 14.43.010.

If the applicant does not agree with the above condition(s) and wishes to appeal the decision, the applicant must file a notice to the Development Services Department. The appeal will then be placed on the next available Planning Commission agenda.
