Dear Mr. Larsen,

As per our phone conversation this morning about Items 3 & 4 on the the agenda for the Provo Planning Commission Hearing on Wednesday, June 9, 2021, I am expressing some concerns, as follows:

- 1) Increasing the population density by changing the zoning classification from Residential Conservation (RC) to Medium Density Residential (MDR) raises questions about the sustainability of *existing infrastructure and services*. Will this result in increasing the **taxes** on adjacent properties?
- 2) If this proposal is approved and goes forward, will this increase the need for *police patrols and services*. Especially concerning is the possibility that this will not become a hotbed of ethnic and indigent strife--much like one hears occurring in West Valley City.
- 3) In very large cities such as London, U.K., "large green space" is provided for the public to recreate, compete in sports, etc. I believe this may be in an effort to allow diversion from day to day stress. What "*green space*" is available to meet these needs if this proposal goes forward?
- 4) What will be the impact on *schools* if the changes occur?
