EROSION CONTROL

- Protect soil piles with an approved BMP method.
- Protect (on-site) storm drain inlets and around the project with an approved BMP.
- At the end of each work day, sweep or scrape up any soil that was tracked onto the road.
- By the end of the next work day after a storm, clean up any soil that may have been washed offsite.
- Inspect remove sediment deposits.
- Secure bags of cement after they are open. Be sure to keep windblown cement powder away from gutters, storm drains and runoff.
- Place concrete washout in an approved designated washout area.
- Concrete can be washed out in a secure plastic lined area.
