POOL OWNERS

Waste water generated by pools can contain contaminants such as chlorine, muriatic acid, solids from filtration and sulfur compounds.

- Hot tub/pool discharges having a bromine or chlorine content of anything above zero parts per million (ppm) is considered an illicit discharge and is subject to fines and/or penalties. The owner is required to provide the test.
- All discharging of pool water must be documented and approved by the Provo City Storm Water Division.
