## The following is a brief summary of the above decision, including conditions of approval:

The DRC discussed how the building would be connected to the existing building from Phase I and is designed to match the existing building. The amount of stucco was discussed and that it would need to comply with the design standards in the code. Staff has since confirmed that 14.34.287 allows no more than 20% stucco per façade.

Members of the public commented on the design saying that it was too bulky and intrusive in nature. The height of the structure being three stories does not fit with what was originally approved or with the surrounding homes in the area.
