

UOCAVA ELECTION NOTICE

The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) Notice

Positions available for the 2023 Election:

City Council District 1 – 4-year term City Council District 3 – 4-year term City Council District 4 – 4-year term City Council City Wide II – 4-year term

The City of Provo will hold a non-partisan municipal General Election on Tuesday, **November 7**, **2023**. If more than two candidates file for an office, a primary election will be held on Tuesday, **August 15**, **2023**.

Candidate Filing Period:

Begins June 1, 2023 through June 7, 2023 between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., excluding Saturday and Sunday. A Candidate shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder at Provo City Hall. A fee of \$75 will be required at the time of filing.

Any resident of a municipality may nominate a candidate for a municipal office by filing a nomination petition and paying the filing fee with the City Recorder during the candidate filing period.

In lieu of paying the filing fee, individuals filing as candidates may submit a petition in support of candidacy, see Provo City Code 2.05.015 for additional information.

Candidates must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Section 20A-9-203.
