



NOTICE OF EARLY VOTING AND DROP BOXES FOR PROVO CITY'S 2023 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

The Municipal General Election for Provo City is scheduled for November 21, 2023. The election will primarily be conducted through mail-in ballots. To ensure your vote is counted, make sure your ballot is postmarked by November 20, 2023.

For in-person early voting, you can visit the Utah County Building between 8 AM and 5 PM from November 13, 2023 until November 20, 2023. Mail-in ballots can be deposited in drop boxes until 8 PM on Election Day. Additionally, provisional ballot registration will be available at any vote center.
