

MINOR PROJECT PLAN

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The purpose of this application is to review minor projects for all multi-family, commercial and industrial buildings. Requests that involve exterior modifications, new additions, and/or landscaping will require Design Review approval. The projects listed below are subject to minor project plan review:

- 1. Any exterior changes to an existing structure. This includes changes to the exterior materials and colors, including: wall veneer (brick, stucco, siding, etc.), roofing shingles or tiles, facia, soffets, base, trim and accent paint colors.
- 2. Any nonstructural improvements (landscaping, parking, etc.) to an existing commercial, office, industrial, or multi-family project.
- 3. Any new one family residential structure that has been sent to the Design Review Committee by the Planning Commission.

Below is a list of information that is required to be submitted with the application in order for City staff to process the request. If any of the required information is not submitted, the application will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted.

lf t	he project requires approval from the Design Review Committee, the following materials will be required:
	Colored landscape plan.
	Colored elevations.
	One color and materials board, 11"x17" minimum, stating the name and address of the project and displaying all exterior materials including: wall brick, stucco and/or siding; roofing; facia and soffets; base trim and accent paint colors. Color photos will not be accepted.

It is recommended that design professionals (architects, engineers and landscape architects) be involved early in the process.

Projects receiving approval must be constructed according to the approved plans. Unauthorized changes to an approved plan will result in an additional fee as set forth in 14.43.010, Provo City Code. Building permits must be obtained prior to the start of construction.
