ITEM 1

Corey Middleton requests Design Review Approval to add a canopy/trellis to the east and south elevations of an existing building located at 515 North University Avenue in the DT1 Zone. *North Park Neighborhood*. 16-0007MPPA, Dustin Wright, 801-852-6414

The following action was taken on the above described item by the Design Review Committee during its regular meeting on February 25, 2016:

The following is a brief summary of the above decision, including conditions of approval:

- The owner described that the canopy additions will be added in a way that they are easily removed to preserve the architecture of the building.
- The width of the canopy along the south façade was discussed and a suggestion was made that it be extended to the East and West to proportionally fill the south façade similar to the way the proposed front trellis fills the front façade. The materials that were presented did not show a lot of detail, especially for the trellis. Front and side elevations of front trellis did not agree. Missing 8" member on front elevation.
- The conditions for approval are for the applicant to come back to staff with final plans that include more detail for approval, and there was a strong suggestion that the applicant revisits the canopy on the south façade to make it fit more proportionally with the front façade.

Unauthorized changes to the approved plan are subject to a \$500.00 fee as outlined in Provo City Code Section 14.43.010.

If the applicant does not agree with the above condition(s) and wishes to appeal the decision, the applicant must file a notice to the Community Development Department. The appeal will then be placed on the next available Planning Commission agenda.
